You will never walk alone – Get to know our Buddy-Program

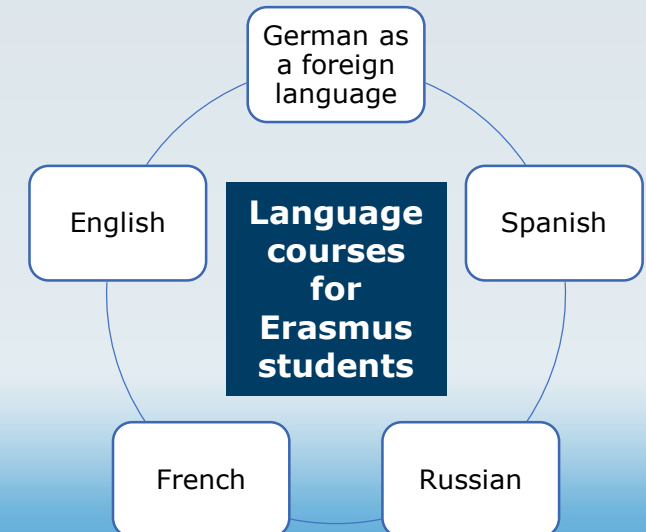
